

Testimony of Dorothy Phoenix

"In September of 2019, our 90 year- old mom's health started rapidly declining. She was hospitalized twice and, in November, she was admitted to a nursing home for rehab. After 4 weeks of tiring sessions, mom didn't have the energy to keep going. She missed being with her children and family, after all; she had never been separated from us overnight due to an illness. We knew what she wanted, and that was to come home. Within 3 days, we had to complete the most important job in our lives; we needed to find a personal home care agency that would meet our needs.
